Eligibility Criteria for Admission (2023-24) to the 1st Semester of Four-Year (Eight Semester) UG-Courses.

Year of passing (last qualifying Exam): Only candidates who have passed H.S. (10+2) or equivalent in the year 2021, 2022 and 2023 are eligible to apply for admission to UG courses.

Candidates should pass H.S. (10+2) or equivalent examination conducted either by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or by other State Board/Council, or The W.B. Council of Rabindra Open Schooling, or The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) recognised by the Distant Education Bureau (DEB).

In case of other Board/ Council, candidates must have pass-marks in 5 (FIVE) recognised subjects of full marks 100, of which one must be English.

Candidates passing from the **W.B. State Council of Technical & Vocational Education & Skill Development** (WBSCTVE&SD) or any equivalent board/council, are eligible for admission in Four-Year UG-Courses provided that the candidate must have passed in 5 (five) recognized subjects, of which one must be English..

Aggregate Marks in H.S. or Equivalent Exam: The sum of marks obtained in the **Best 4 (FOUR)** Subjects is to be considered as Aggregate Marks.

The subject Compulsory Environmental Studies (if any) shall not be considered in Best 4 (FOUR) Subjects.

A candidate is required to choose not more than one subject (Minor) from any of the groups mentioned below.

Groups:

Gr. I: Physics, Zoology.

Gr. II: Mathematics, History.

Gr. III: Chemistry, Sanskrit.

Gr. IV: Botany, Economics.

Gr. V: Political Science.

Gr. VI: Geography, Philosophy.

Gr. VII: Physiology, Statistics, English.

Gr. VIII: Bengali.

A candidate shall be allowed to take up the subject(s) under heading '(A)' for Major/Minor subjects if he/she has passed the subject(s) under heading '(B)' in the previous qualifying examination.
